#### 1. Who are we?



We are the West Dunbartonshire Neurodevelopmental Service and we have been asked to meet you! This is called an appointment.

## 2. Why are you going to meet us?



Our job is to find out about how you talk to people, make friends, and manage at school and at home.

We want to know what you like to do and what you don't like to do

## 3. Where will we meet you?



Your parent/carer will bring you to our centre. This may be at the Vale of Leven Hospital or the West Centre. We may also visit you at school.

## 4. What will you do when you get here?

We will look at some pictures and a book together. We might play with some toys and also do a puzzle.



When we have finished talking to you, you can go home or back to school

We will arrange another appointment to talk to your parent/carer about what we found out

They can ask us some questions.



We will write down what we think in a letter and send it to your parent/carer. They can talk to you about this.
